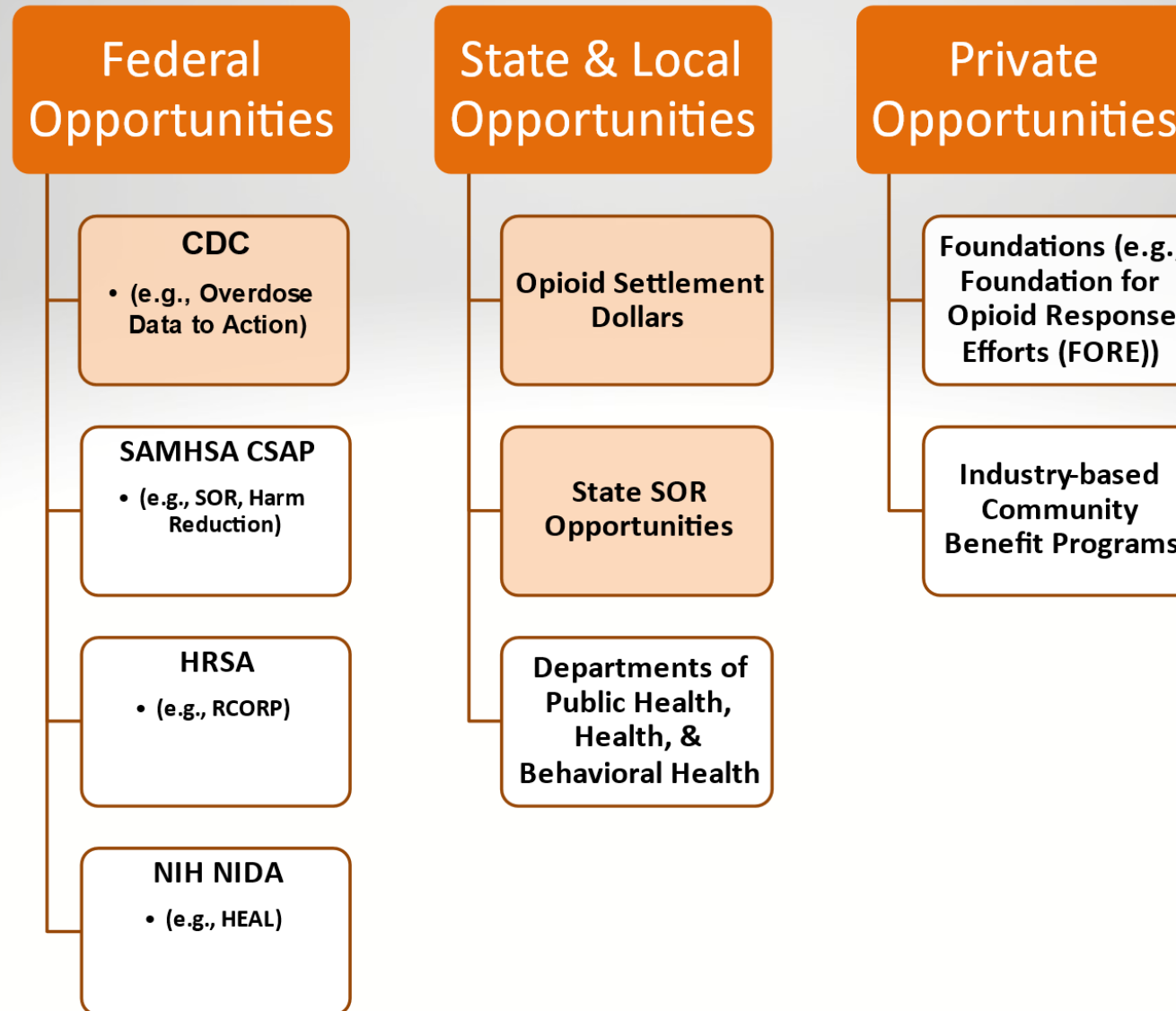


# Possible Funding Opportunities to Support CRT Efforts



**\$1.4 Trillion awarded to states and territories from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Agency (SAMHSA) for the State Opioid Response(SOR) Fund (2022 – 2024). This is the third wave of SOR funding.**

## **SAMSHA's SOR 3**

- In California, SOR II funds (Oct. 2020 - Sept. 2022) funded two pilot CRT programs in Madera County and Sutter & Yuba Counties
- In California, SOR III funds were awarded to fund the continuation of two CRT locations and to create and build four more
- Funds are granted by SAMHSA to the state health care authority and every state is spending its money differently
- The effective date of the current funding began on September 30th, so we are anticipating RFPs rolling out in many states

## CDC's Overdose Data to Action (OD2A)

# CDC's OD2A

- CDC launched the multiyear Overdose Data to Action (OD2A) cooperative agreement in September 2019 with **66 recipients** (referred to as jurisdictions) comprising state, territorial, county, and city health departments.
- Two-pronged approach:
  - Surveillance: morbidity, mortality and innovative surveillance strategies.
  - Prevention: PDMP, State and local integration, linkages to care, provider and health systems support, partnerships with public safety, first responders, empowering individuals and innovative preventive strategies.
- Peer to peer learning.
